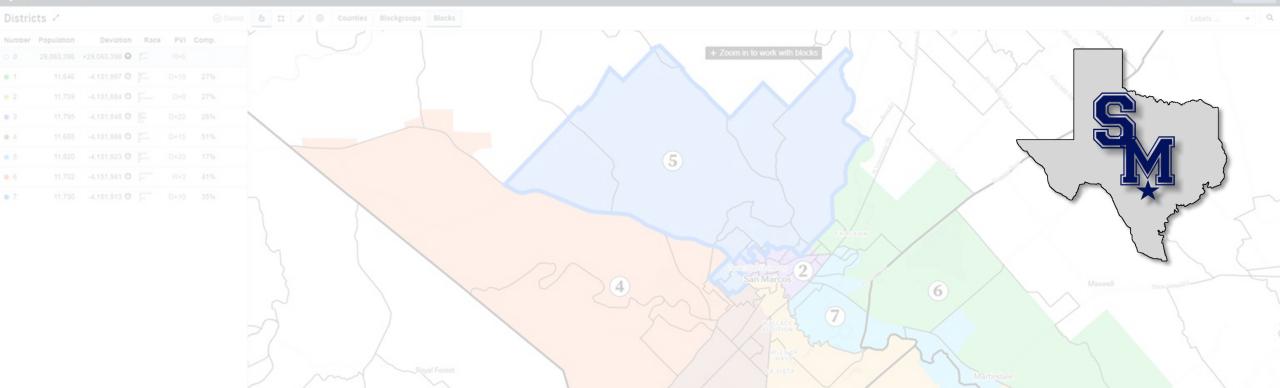

Community Redistricting Committee San Marcos Consolidated ISD Update (2023-06-19)

Status Update

Committee met virtually on Zoom on May 24, 2023, at 6:30 PM.

Meeting Notes:

- Did not have a quorum for last official meeting
- Developed 4 proposed maps for a 7-0 configuration
- New Board Trustees can appoint committee members if desired
- Need to meet to discuss the 4 proposed (in-person is preferred)

Biggest issue is attendance. We are moving forward to keep our schedule.

All 4 proposed maps comply with the objective and sociodemographic statistics.

In summary:

- Proposals A & D are based on the elementary school zones (one with paired Trustees and one with each Trustee having their own district).
- Proposal B is a modified plan based on the current 5-2 configuration with each Trustee in their own district.
- Proposal C is a compact configuration with some Trustees paired

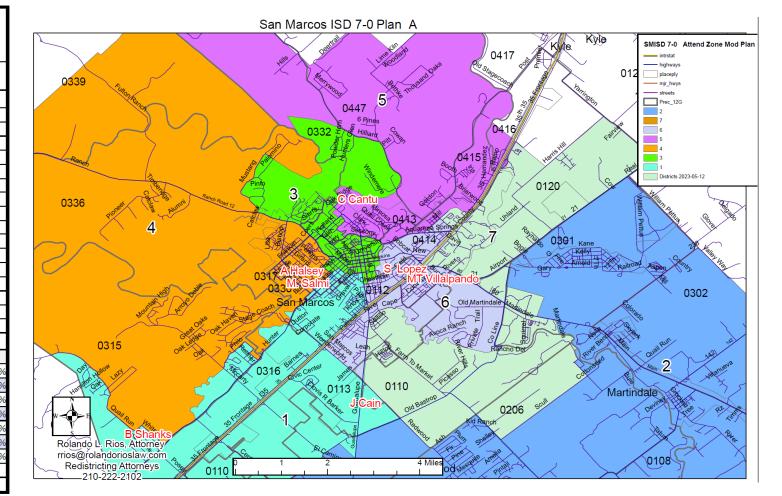

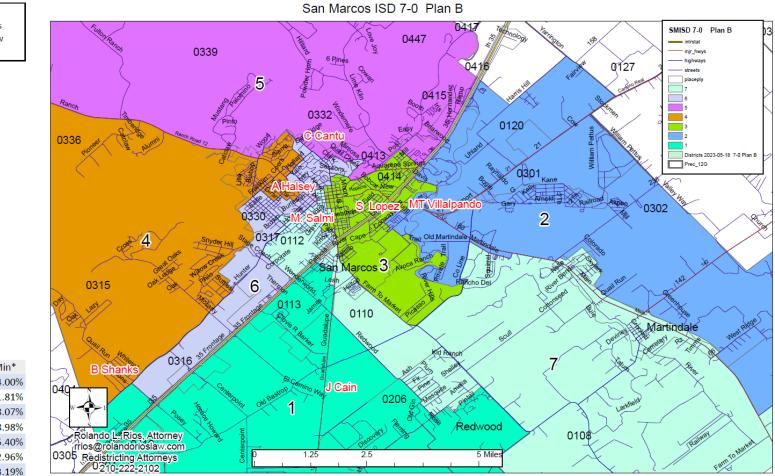
