Dear Parents of Elementary Students,

Some adjustments have been made to our Elementary At-Home Learning plans. The changes are broken down by dates.

Lessons for April 6 - 9: At-Home Learning lessons will be on the district's At-home Learning site and will be provided at pick up/grab-and-go sites on Monday, April 6, and Wednesday, April 8. Your child's teacher will also have these lessons in their Google Classrooms.

- **REQUIRED activities:**
 - Please have your child complete the "STAR" activity for both reading and math, and one of the optional activities for reading and math.

- **OPTIONAL activities:**
 - At-home science activity
 - A "choice board" of fun activities and extra practice

Lessons and Activities beginning April 13: Beginning Monday, April 13, students will be given an At-Home Learning mini-project that includes science, math, reading, and writing. The work can be completed throughout the week as family schedules allow.

How to complete work and turn it in:

- Option 1 - Digital instruction:
 - Teachers will provide their lessons digitally via Google Classroom. *There will be no need to print out lessons or pick up packets.*
 - Work can also be turned in digitally through Google Classroom or pictures can be taken and the work can be emailed to the child's teacher.

- Option 2 - Printed instruction:
 - You can pick up an At-Home learning packet at a grab-and-go site
 - Print packet at home from the district website (if preferred)
 - To turn work in, pictures can be taken and the work can be emailed to the child's teacher, or the work can be dropped off at your child's campus.

Important Note: Teachers will continue to offer virtual meetings and office hours each week to provide support and stay in contact with students and families. Optional activities and digital resources for more learning opportunities are available on the district website's At-Home Learning page, and through teachers' Google Classrooms.
