Why are these dates important?

There are several key items that will be addressed in the 2020-2021 School year. Our SHAC will also have to address any new passed legislation from the current legislative session.

May Orientation/Strategy Session: This is a planning session for the 2020-2021 school year open to the entire SHAC and is a 2-hour working session. The objectives for this meeting:

- Identify the 2020-2021 Working Group Memberships (Chair(s) and members)
- Validate the 2020 – 2021 SHAC meeting dates, proposed 1st Thursdays of the months Sept, Nov., Jan., March and any other as determined
- Identify the initial topics for each committee to address in 2020-2021
- Schedule all 2020 – 2021 Working Group meetings and prepare for publish to the website
- Review current proposed legislation during the current legislative session
- One of the primary activities is the Bylaws Review by the Executive Committee. This activity must be completed before the 2020-2021 school year begins and is crucial to maintaining governance for the SHAC.
- This will allow for the Working groups to start meeting in August 2020 and allow for more productivity in 2020-2021.
- This will allow maximum participation from our volunteers because it will occur during the school year before summer vacation begins.
